Definitions and/or Descriptions of School District Meetings

- 1. District Board Meetings** – San Bruno Park School District has a “Board” that is the decision making system of the District which is done by the elected five (5) members of the Governing Board. The “Board” normally meets once a month on the second Wednesday. These meetings are accessible to the public in “Open” Session which begins at 7:00 PM. Most meetings take place at the district offices, located at 500 Acacia Avenue in San Bruno.
- 2. Community Coffee Hour with Superintendent** – The Superintendent’s coffee hour conversations will be in conjunction with the San Bruno Chamber’s monthly meetings, now moved to the second Wednesday of the month. The Chamber meetings will be from 9□10:30 a.m. followed by the Superintendent’s Coffee hours from 10:30□11:30 a.m. to be held at the Bay Area Entrepreneur Center, 458 San Mateo Avenue in San Bruno.
- 3. DELAC - District English Learner Advisory Committee** – Same as ELAC, but districtwide and they meet on a quarterly basis. **ELAC - English Learner Advisory Committee** –Each California public school, grades kindergarten through 12, with 21 or more English learners must form an ELAC. The ELAC shall be responsible for advising the principal and staff on programs and services for English learners and the School Site Council on the development of the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). ELAC shall assist the school in the development of the school's needs assessment, school's annual language census and ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.
- 4. LCAP - LCAP** is a critical part of the new Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). Each school district must engage parents, educators, employees and the community to establish these plans. The plans will describe the school district’s overall vision for students, annual goals and specific actions the district will take to achieve the vision and goals. The LCAPs must focus on eight areas identified as state priorities. The plans will also demonstrate how the district’s budget will help achieve the goals, and assess each year how well the strategies in the plan were able to improve outcomes.
- 5. Children’s Day** – Day of the child is a national celebration of children and the magic of reading that is observed by SBPSD on the last Saturday of April. Nationally, it is known as Day of the Child – Day of Books or Día de los Niños – Día de los Libros.
- 6. Graduation Day** – Day of celebration for 5th graders, ready to move on to middle school, 8th graders moving up to high school, and may also include graduations for our Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten classes.
