Goals – reading comprehension through writing;

Focus will be on developing reading comprehension through the writing process and also the areas of grammar and writing strategies.

Math; number sense will be developed by increasing math fluency through mastery of basic facts.

Dr. Dunleavy's Math Boot Camp will run for seven weeks in the fall. Students not demonstrating mastery of basic facts will be required to attend. Students will have a weekly opportunity to test out.
