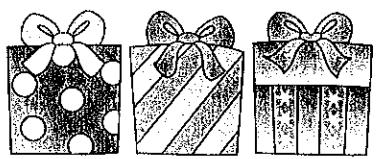

How to Receive Toys:

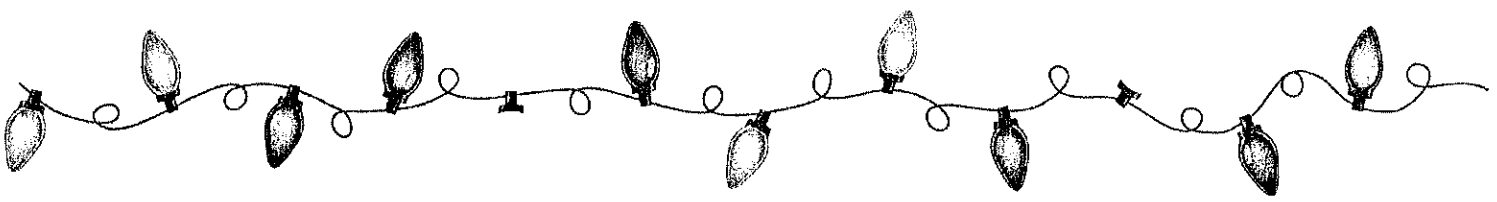
- Must be a San Bruno resident. Verification required.

San Bruno Firefighters Toy Program Guidelines

- Only one application per family will be accepted. You must be the parent or legal guardian of the child/children that you are applying for.
- You **MUST** be a resident of San Bruno to apply for this program
- San Bruno Firefighters Toy Program is for children aged infant through age 17, living in San Bruno.
- You must be present to pick up toys; no one else can pick toys up for you.
- Valid Identification is required for the parent or guardian and for each child to obtain toys.
- If you are legal guardian of the child you must present proof of such.

Important Dates:

- December 15th – Last day for sign ups
- December 23rd – Pick up your toys between 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM
