KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION: Kindergarten registration for the 2018-2019 school year starts on January 16. Students must turn 5 on or before September 1, 2018. If your child turns 5 between Sept. 2, 2018 and Dec. 2, 2018, they can enroll in Transitional Kindergarten. Registration packets will not be accepted unless they are complete.

The following are required:

1. Original birth certificate
2. Current immunization record
3. Two proofs of address: PG&E, utility bill, telephone bill, lease with a cancelled check



CAASPP (statewide performance assessment): The testing window is from the end of April through the end of May. Be sure to contact your child's teacher for specific testing dates. Please schedule appointments around those dates to help ensure that your child tests under the best possible conditions.
